He is also on the Steering Committee of the Progressive Zionist Alliance, the Philadelphia Affiliate of Brit Tzedek.

An activist for peace and human rights in Israel. For six years, Director of the New Israel Fund. She has been a member of Women in Black since its founding in 1988 and co-founded the Coalition of Women for Peace. She was Executive Director of Bat Shalom (the Israeli side of the Israeli-Palestinian "Jerusalem Link") and chairperson of B'Tselem, two leading peace and human rights organizations. She was awarded two major peace prizes and was invited to speak at the U.N. Security Council on the role of women in peace negotiations.
